II There is a cost for that sin!

Diromanin 6:23 Anerae eropit njolo ka asecit njese atwanare; nai ainakinet njina a ikonjin njina ka Akuj njese akiyar njina nyedaun alotooma Yesu Kristo Ekapolon yok.

Akiseleerekinet 21:8 Nai njikakuryanak, njikalukinok, njulu nyenupito, njikaarak, njimalaanotin, njikekukujak, njulu ilipete neni a njakujo ka njikalyokonok daadanj imasakinio ikes nanam njina ka akim ka njina a Sulpa. Erae njin atwanare njina a njaree.”

Akiseleerekinet 20:11-15 Abu oanyuwa ekicolonj njolo akwanj njolo apolon ka njese njini icolonjit. Tonjopiyasi akwap

ka nakuj alokiñaren keñ nyeanyuwar nabo jik. Abu eñolik ñikatwak, ñikarwok ka ñicaryo ewuasi kaapei alokiñaren ekicolon, toñaarae ñikitaaboi. Toñaarae nabo ekitaabo ece, ekitaabo ñolo ka akiyar. Aponi totubokinae ñikatwak ikwañina kitiyatotor ikes, ikwapei igiritere lokitaaboi. Toleku anam ñikatwak ñulu ayakasi tooma keñ. Tolekut Atwanare ka Akibois ñina a ñikatwak dañ ñikatwak ñulu ayakasi neni kec. Aponi totubokinae ikes daadañ ikwañina kitiyatotor ikes. Kimasakinae nai Atwanare ka Akibois ñina a ñikatwak nanam ñina ka akim. (Erae anam ñina ka akim ñin atwanare ñina a ñaarei.) Ituñanan ñini pa ayai ekiro keñ lokitaabo ñolo ka akiyar, aponi kimasakinae nanam ñina ka akim.

III Christ died for our sins.

Diromanin 5:6 Anerae ani eriña iwon ikipalag añauna ikipukator aseñit iwon, abu Kristo totwan añauna yok a ñikasecak apaki ñina aseñit Akuj.

Diromanin 5:8 Nai ikitoodik Akuj iwon etyae ñolo ikiminar iñes iwon, anerae abu Kristo totwan añauna yok eriña iwon ikirae ñikasecak.

Diromanin 14:9 Anerae abu Kristo totwan ka toyaru añauna ka aruwor Ekapolon a ñulu eyarete ka ñulu atwak.

Diromanin 6:23 Anerae eropit ñolo ka aseñit iñes atwanare; nai ainakinet ñina a ikonin ñina ka Akuj iñes akiyar ñina nyedaun alotooma Yesu Kristo Ekapolon yok.



Christ died for sinners!

IV Salvation is a free gift, not by good works. You must take God's word for it, and trust Jesus alone!

Salvation is trusting and receiving Jesus Christ as your Savior. It's trusting in the fact that Jesus Christ died on the cross of Calvary to pay for your sins! It's realizing there is absolutely nothing whatsoever you can do to save yourself and *completely* trusting in Jesus Christ to save you! It's not any church that saves. It's not any baptism, not good works, not sacraments, not repenting, not praying through, not living a good life — IT'S NOT ANYTHING YOU CAN DO!

Niticisyo 4:12 Emam aiuno aneni a ice a daadañ, anerae emam ekiro ece anakwap a daadañ ñolo einit Akuj ñituña, ñolo epedoryata ñituña aiunor.”

Diepesoi 2:8-9 Anerae erae añauna ka ajokis a ñina ka Akuj ikiunere iyees, aiuno ñina ipotu iyees toryamut ananupit kus.

Meere aḡuna a ḡiticiṣyo kus ikiunere iyēs, nai erae aiuno ainakinet ḡina ka Akuj, ikotere nyiturokin idiotuḡanan aḡuna ka ainakinet a ḡin.

Tito 3:5 abu iḡēs ikiu iwōn. Pa arae aḡuna a ḡiticiṣyo a ḡidi a ḡulu ajokak a ḡulu ikitiyat iwōn, nai arae aḡuna ka akisiyon keḡ ka alope abunio iḡēs ikiunia iwōn. Abu iḡēs ikiu iwōn, ikitesegu iwōn anakidouno a ḡina a ḡaarei ka ikituruwo iwōn ḡulu kitet aneni ke Etau a ḡolo Aseḡan.



V We must put our faith and trust in Christ in order to be saved.

Diromanin 4:24 Egiritae aḡuna yok daḡ a ḡulu elosi Akuj acamun erae ḡulu iyookino, iwōn ḡulu ikinupit Akuj ḡina eteyaruni Yesu Ekapolon yok alokatwak.

Diromanin 10:9-10,13 9Ani kilimu ka akituk kon atemar, “Erae Yesu Ekapolon” ka tonup alotau kon atemar abu Akuj kiteyaru iḡēs alokatwak, iiun iyōḡ. Anerae ikinupit iwōn alotai yok, ido ikituruwor ḡulu ikiyookino alokiḡaren Akuj; ikilimu iwōn a ḡakitukwa yok, ido ikiun. Ikwapei ebaakatar ḡakigireta ebe, “Ḋinituḡanan ilipi alokiro a ḡolo ke Ekapolon, eiun.”



If you want to accept Jesus Christ as your Savior and receive forgiveness from God, here is prayer you can pray. Saying this prayer or any other prayer will not save you. It is only trusting

in Jesus Christ that can provide forgiveness of sins. This prayer is simply a way to express to God your faith in Him and thank Him for providing for your forgiveness.

"Lord,

I know that I am a sinner. I know that I deserve the consequences of my sin, which is death and hell. However, I am trusting in Jesus Christ as my Savior. I believe that His death and resurrection provided for my forgiveness. I trust in Jesus and Jesus alone as my personal Lord and Savior. Thank you Lord, for saving me and forgiving me! Amen!"

If you just prayed that prayer — according to the Word of God — YOU ARE SAVED! HALLELUJAH!

You say, but I don't feel any different. Guess what? Your salvation does not depend on your feeling. **It ALL depends on doing what God SAID!**

God said if you receive and trust in Jesus Christ you are saved. Notice it does NOT say you "might" or "could" be saved — but "shall be saved". **YOU ARE SAVED!**
