


GOD'S SIMPLE PLAN OF SALVATION FROM JOHN



Why did Jesus die?

1. Man by nature does evil (wrong).

It is not hard to admit that we all have done things that we know is wrong, but yet we do them anyway. That is called sin! We all are guilty of it we have been doing it since we were born.

Yohana 3:19 Atubokino ijēs na ebe: abu akica bu nakwap, nai aminasi njitūja akiryonut akilo akica, anerae aroko njuna etiyaete ikes.



We are all sinners!

2. By that nature we are condemned.

Yoana 6:40 Duna ecamit Papa kañ ikes nu: njini eanyuni ka tonup Lokoku, eryamuni akiyar njina nyedaun. Eteyaruni ayonj ijēs Akoloñit njina esidyon.”

Yoana 3:18 Ijēs njini enupi Lokoku ka Akuj, nyetubokinio; njini nyenupi, etubokinitae sek, anerae nyenupit ijēs ekiro a a Lokoku ka Akuj a njolo donupei.

Yoana 3:36 Dini enupi Lokoku, ijes eyakar akiyar njina nyedaun; njini nyepupi Lokoku, nyeryamuni akiyar njin, nai eyai anyunyura njina ka Akuj neni keɗ.



There is a cost for sin!

3. Jesus was in the world and he died for us.

Yoana 14:6 Tolimok Yesu Tomas tema, “Arae Ayoɗ erot, Arae njuna a kire ka Arae akiyar; nyepedori ituɗanan abunore neni a Papa, mati kitoru neni kaɗ.

Yoana 3:17 Anerae pa eyakuunit Akuj Lokoku keɗ atubokin akwap, nai ikotere eunio akwap aɗuna keɗ.

Yoana 1:10,12 Ayai Akirot nakwap, tosub Akuj akwap aneni keɗ, nai nyeyenuna akwap ijes. Nai njulu daadaɗ apotu kijaut ijes, tonupa ekiro keɗ, abu ijes inak ikes apedor njina ruworet njidwe njulu ka Akuj.

4. Salvation is a free gift, not by good works. You must take God’s word for it, and trust Jesus alone!

Salvation is trusting and receiving Jesus Christ as your Savior. It's trusting in the fact that Jesus Christ died on the cross of Calvary to pay for your sins! It's realizing there is absolutely nothing whatsoever you can do to save yourself and *completely* trusting in Jesus Christ to save you! It's not any church that saves. It's not any baptism, not good works, not sacraments, not repenting, not praying through, not living a good life — **IT'S NOT ANYTHING YOU CAN DO!**

Niticisyo 4:12 Emam aiuno aneni a ice a daadaɗ, anerae emam ekiro ece anakwap a daadaɗ njolo einit Akuj njituɗa, njolo epedoryata njituɗa aiunor.”

Diepesoi 2:8-9 Anerae erae aɗuna ka ajokis a njina ka Akuj ikiunere iyes, aiuno njina ipotu iyes toryamut ananupit kus. Meere aɗuna a njiticisyo kus ikiunere iyes, nai erae aiuno ainakinet njina ka Akuj, ikotere nyiturokin idiotuɗanan aɗuna ka ainakinet a njin.

Tito 3:5 abu ijes ikiu iwon. Pa arae aɗuna a njiticisyo a njidi a njulu ajokak a njulu ikitiyat iwon, nai arae aɗuna ka akisyon keɗ ka alope abunio ijes ikiunia iwon. Abu ijes ikiu iwon, ikitesegu iwon anakidouno a njina a njaree ka ikituruwo iwon

ηulu kitet aneni ke Etao a ηolo Asegan.

5. You must believe on the Lord and you will have everlasting life!

Yoana 5:24 “Akalmokini ayon iyes kire atemar, ηini iirari akaakiroto, ido tonup iηes ηolo ekeyakuunit ayon, eyakar akiyar ηina nyedaun, nyetubokinio iηes, nai alunyar iηes anatwanare nakiyar.”

Yoana 6:47 Akalmokini ayon iyes kire atemar, ηini enupi, eryamuni akiyar ηina nyedaun.

Yoana 10:28 Ainakini ayon ikes akiyar ηina nyedaun, nyebukorosi ikes jik, emam daη ηini ekopori ikes anakan kaη.



If you want to accept Jesus Christ as your Savior and receive forgiveness from God, here is prayer you can pray. Saying this prayer or any other prayer will not save you. It is only trusting in Jesus Christ that can provide forgiveness of sins. This prayer is simply a way to express to God your faith in Him and thank Him for providing for your forgiveness.



"Lord,

I know that I am a sinner. I know that I deserve the consequences of my sin which is death and hell. However, I am trusting in Jesus Christ as my Savior. I believe that His death and resurrection provided for my forgiveness. I trust in Jesus and Jesus alone as my personal Lord and Savior. Thank you Lord, for saving me and forgiving me! Amen!"

If you just prayed that prayer — according to the Word of God — YOU ARE SAVED! HALLELUJAH!

You say, but I don't feel any different. Guess what? Your salvation does not depend on your feeling. **It ALL depends on doing what God SAID!**

God said if you receive and trust in Jesus Christ you are saved. Notice it does NOT say you "might" or "could" be saved — but "shall be saved". **YOU ARE SAVED!**
