Introduction

The Bible is very clear that you can know for sure that when you die that you can go to heaven. The question is do you believe what God says in his word.

1. We are all sinners!

It is not hard to admit that we all have done things that we know is wrong, but yet we do them anyway. That is called sin! We all are guilty of it we have been doing it since we were born.

2. There is a cost for your sin!

1 Yohana 5:19 Wot a to tɔk, wot a sé vê Dagwi, mwa ano de wò neves a sé re negwɔm e ra jey yemo mwa.

1 Yohana 5:12 Kawe mwat de a vɔk Hwey mɛ mo e yey mɛ a vɔk neken o, ko kawe mwat de a vɔk Hwey Dagwi e yey mɛ wet a vɔk neken o wet.

1 Yohana 3:15 Kawε mwat de e kyé ε gwa με a sé mwât mɔ̀bɔs bemat. Ko yin a tɔ̀k, vit a mwât mɔ̀bɔs bemat de a vɔ̀k neken gbak-gbak e ji με.

3. Jesus died and paid for our sins on the cross!

1 Yohana 4:9-10 Gwong de Dagwi á dura a wot, a tɛ̀ yey na wot gwa sé ngan: Á tomo Hwey με de ha sé nju he zɔ̀ng vey e jey, yaga na wot a bin vɔ̀k neken yi na he. 10Yerê tɛ̀ yey de me ha e ra he ha sé ngan: A sé e wot de wot a tɛ̀ yey na Dagwi wet, ko a sé e ye de a tɛ̀ yey na wot, ko a tomo Hwey με, na he sè gwong de Dagwi e hala a wot banen mot.



Christ died for sinners!

1 Yohana 4:2-3 Gwong de yin a rɔ̀da tɔ̀k ke mwat a vɔ̀k Gabik Dagwi a gwot: Kawε mwat de e ha wesherek wɔ̀gɔ, Yesu Kristi á vey e jey na rebêk mwasi, e ye de a vɔ̀k Gabik Dagwi. Ko kawε mwat de e tono wɔ̀gɔ, Yesu á té ε mwasi, a vɔ̀k Gabik Dagwi wet. Ko a vɔ̀k gabik wo repugû Kristi. Yin á kana wok, ha sé kyè vey, ko a remo, ha ga kana yel e jey.

1 Yohana 5:11 Ko pyé de a ha mo ya sé wɔ̀gɔ, Dagwi a ga nɔ̀ng ot neken nesheneshey, ko a ga nɔ̀ng ot neken o yi na Hwey με.

4. We must put our faith and trust in Christ alone!

1 Yohana 5:14-15 Wot a vɔ̀k yey ting e nuyêl Dagwi, yaga wot a tɔ̀k, ye e wok ot kaye jeng de wot e ra wôn pye cak de ya sé tyeng na pye de e simo. Sede remo de wot a tɔ̀k, ye e wok ot jeng de wot e ra wôn pye cak, ano kwong wot a to tɔ̀k, wot a ga sè pye de wot a ra won o na ye.

Roma 10:9-10, 13 Ka sede hwà hanat wesherek na nu mō wɔ̀gɔ, “Yesu a sé Darwey”, na hwo sey tsak o e yey mō wɔ̀gɔ, Dagwi a sene he yi e reku, ko ba rɔ̀da sey neken mō. Yaga a sé na yey de mwat e sey tsak o, ko Dagwi e tɛ̀ ε na a sè cik e bayis με. A to sé yi na nu με de mwat o e hanat wesherek wɔ̀gɔ, Yesu a sé Darwey, ko Dagwi e sey neken με. Sede remo de bà jek wɔ̀gɔ, “Kawε mwat de e yishi Dagwi na a sele he, ko Dagwi a rɔ̀da sey ε.”

If you want to accept Jesus Christ as your Savior and receive forgiveness from God, here is prayer you can pray. Saying this prayer or any other prayer will not save you. It is only trusting

in Jesus Christ that can provide forgiveness of sins. This prayer is simply a way to express to God your faith in Him and thank Him for providing for your forgiveness.

"Lord,

I know that I am a sinner. I know that I deserve the consequences of my sin. However, I am trusting in Jesus Christ as my Savior. I believe that His death and resurrection provided for my forgiveness. I trust in Jesus and Jesus alone as my personal Lord and Savior. Thank you Lord, for saving me and forgiving me! Amen!"

If you just prayed that prayer — according to the Word of God — YOU ARE SAVED! HALLELUJAH!

You say, but I don't feel any different. Guess what? Your salvation does not depend on your feeling. **It ALL depends on doing what God SAID!**

God said if you receive and trust in Jesus Christ you are saved. Notice it does NOT say you "might" or "could" be saved — but "shall be saved". **YOU ARE SAVED!**
