The Bible is very clear that you can know for sure that when you die that you can go to heaven. The question is do you believe what God says in his word.

1. We are all sinners!

Kaanjaat aboña afelumi búyegetool man areg mati Yensa Apakenaau Áamakau abilumi nan an, an akila nababaj Búyegetab Bátienaab bati Atijamit. Bare aboña alatumi man aregumo mati Yensa, oo ápurumulout di Atijamit. An akila nababaj búyeget bati Alatooraau ati Apakenaau Áamakau. Muyuul jijanjam mati alatooraau akila panabil bee di dúniyaay, ban súm náriinuloriin.

1 Yohan 5:11 Mo'ome moo eenomi káyiisenak kan Atijamit asenolaami. Nasenolaasen eroŋey yati bándoorey, ban eroŋey ekila yooyu di Añoolool.

4. We must put our faith and trust in Christ alone!

1 Yohan 5:14-15 Ban súm fúgolumaf ufe foo nubajaami di oo, mati wanoosani nuceeŋaalool kápurumul di kamaŋak koola, panajamolaal. Umanjaajaat mati wanoosani nuceeŋaaloomi najameolaajam, moo ñaa numanjaal nayayab kúlawak koololaal.

Rooma 10:9-10, 13 Ufelujaat búyegeti man ureg di butumi mati Yensa eenomi Akiiyaau ban nufium di ésigiri mati Atijamit náyitenulooyiten di kacetumi, panubaj epak. Mati anau náyineneyinen di ésigirool man Atijamit asofool an ajoone, ban nafelumi búyegetool man aregumo di butumool, moo napakenipaken. Mati, "Anoosani awonkumi kareesak kati Akiiyaau an akila panapak."

If you want to accept Jesus Christ as your Savior and receive forgiveness from God, here is prayer you can pray. Saying this prayer or any other prayer will not save you.
