


GOD'S SIMPLE PLAN OF SALVATION FROM JOHN



Why did Jesus die?

1. Man by nature does evil (wrong).

It is not hard to admit that we all have done things that we know is wrong, but yet we do them anyway. That is called sin! We all are guilty of it we have been doing it since we were born.

Yoane 3:19 Kibaakakandilua ni keki: Musaniko waizile mu kyalo, inzi bantu batoneesie nfinzi kukila musaniko, pantu bikitua byabo bibiipile.

Baroma 3:23 Bantu bonse babalile, kabili bakeepeelue na bulumba bwakua Leza.



We are all sinners!

2. By that nature we are condemned.

Yoane 6:40 Tawe atonene evi, kubalua muntu wamumona Mwana ni kumuketekela abe ni bukose bwa muyayaya, kabili nkamutuntumune busiku bwa mpeleezio."

Yoane 3:18 Onse amuketekeele Mwina Leza takandilue, inzi asimuketekeele, akandiilue mbeela pantu tamuketekeele Mwana lyonga wakua Leza.

Yoane 3:36 Olia amuketekeele Mwana ali ni bukose bwa muyayaya. Inzi olia asimuketekeele takamona bukose pantu kikonko kyakua Leza kili pali wene.



There is a cost for sin!

3. Jesus was in the world and he died for us.

Yoane 14:6 Yesu waamwanine, "Nene i nzila, nene i kiine, nene i bukose. Tekuli muntu wakuya kuli Tawe kine tapitiile muli nene.

Yoane 3:17 Pantu Leza taatumine Mwana wakue kuti akande bantu ba mu kyalo, inzi waamutumine kuti abapususie.

Yoane 1:10, 12 Ozo Keebo waali mu kyalo. Leza waalengele kyalo na Keebo, inzi bekala kyalo tebaamumanine Keebo. Bonse baamupokeleele ni kumuketekela, Leza waabapeele buvinde bwa kwaluka bena Leza.

4. Salvation is a free gift, not by good works. You must take God's word for it, and trust Jesus alone!

Salvation is trusting and receiving Jesus Christ as your Savior. It's trusting in the fact that Jesus Christ died on the cross of Calvary to pay for your sins! It's realizing there is absolutely nothing whatsoever you can do to save yourself and *completely* trusting in Jesus Christ to save you! It's not any church that saves. It's not any baptism, not good works, not sacraments, not repenting, not praying through, not living a good life — **IT'S NOT ANYTHING YOU CAN DO!**

Acts 4:12 Tekuli unge muntu aliwapususia, inga sie Yesu bunke pantu monse mwaya kyalo, Leza taatupeelemo linge liina lya kuti tupusukilemo."

Baefeso 2:8-9 Mwaapususiiziwe sie na buwame bwakua Leza kupitila mu kiketekelo. Te pa mulandu wa bikitua bya maka enu, inzi ni kyabupe sie kyakua Leza. Kansi muntu tekuti etasie palua bobu bupusuko.

Tito 3:5 waatupususiizie na nkumbu yakue, tekuba pa mulandu wa bikitua biweme bitwaakitile, inzi waatupususiizie na kutusamba. Leza waatusambile na maka a Mweo Muzuuke atulengele kuti tuye twali ni bukose bwa lenu.

5. You must believe on the Lord and you will have everlasting life!

Yoane 5:24 "Namyana kisinka nangue kine muntu wamuketekela Leza mukunvua keebo kane, ali ni bukose bwa muyayaya. Takapingulua, inzi afumine mu lufu, kabili tasyaingiile mu bukose.

Yoane 6:47 Namyana kisinka nangue, olia aliwanketekela ali ni bukose bwa muyayaya.

Yoane 10:28 Ni nene ndinaipeela bukose bwa muyayaya, ni yo teikikazeeza. Kabili tekuli muntu waakansompola mu maboko ane.



If you want to accept Jesus Christ as your Savior and receive forgiveness from God, here is prayer you can pray. Saying this prayer or any other prayer will not save you. It is only trusting in Jesus Christ that can provide forgiveness of sins. This prayer is simply a way to express to God your faith in Him and thank Him for providing for your forgiveness.



"Lord,

I know that I am a sinner. I know that I deserve the consequences of my sin which is death and hell. However, I am trusting in Jesus Christ as my Savior. I believe that His death and resurrection provided for my forgiveness. I trust in Jesus and Jesus alone as my personal Lord and Savior. Thank you Lord, for saving me and forgiving me! Amen!"

If you just prayed that prayer — according to the Word of God — YOU ARE SAVED! HALLELUJAH!

You say, but I don't feel any different. Guess what? Your salvation does not depend on your feeling. **It ALL depends on doing what God SAID!**

God said if you receive and trust in Jesus Christ you are saved. Notice it does NOT say you "might" or "could" be saved — but "shall be saved". **YOU ARE SAVED!**

"Onse aliwamulomba Mulopue ni kumupaapaata kupitila mu Liina lyakue, waakapusuka." Romans 10:13

Didn't you just believe on the Lord Jesus Christ? Look at what John 3:36 says! It says you **HATH EVERLASTING LIFE!** Not "maybe" or "hope so" — **BUT HATH — YOU ARE SAVED!**
