Why did Jesus die?

1. Man by nature does evil (wrong).

John 3:19 "And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil."

Isaya 64.6 Kaufel'a luna se lu fetuhile ba ba na ni masila, mi ku luka kwa luna kaufela ku likana ni likatana ze nyenyisa; mi lwa letuka kaufela sina litali, bumaswe bwa luna bwa lu isa sina moya.



We are all sinners!

2. By that nature we are condemned.

John 6:40 "And this is the will of him that sent me, that every one which seeth the Son, and believeth on him, may have everlasting life: and I will raise him up at the last day."

Lisamu 9.17 Ba ba maswe ba yelela kwa musima, ona macaba kaufela a' libala Mulimu.

John 3:18 "He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God."

John 3:36b "...and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him."



There is a cost for sin!

3. Jesus was in the world and he died for us.

John 14:6 "Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me."

Joani 3.16 "Kakuli Mulimu u latile lifasi ha- hulu, mane u li file Mwan'a hae wa libanda, kuli mutu ufi kamba ufi ya lumela ku yena a si ke a shwa, kono a be ni bupilo bo bu sa feli."

John 3:17 For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved

Joani 1.10, 12 "He was in the world, and the world was made by him, and the world knew him not. Kono bona ba ba mu amuhezi, u ba file mata a ku fetuha bana ba Mulimu, bona ba ba lumela libizo la hae.

- Titus 3:5 Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost;

Acts 4:12 Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.
